### **Military using VA Funding for MCFBD**

MCFBD is obtained once all other certifications have been achieved and then upon passing a comprehensive examination with questions from each of the certifications. Credit given for money already paid for prior certifications.

Note that pricing for civilian classes held outside the U. S. MAY be adjusted for travel and other costs. All certifications require purchase of the book.

Class required for CCP II-III; recommended for HACCP and MCFP; the rest are optional depending on existing knowledge & learning preference. Separate pricing is established because in some cases the employer won't pay for books or classes.
